Growing up with family violence has devastating consequences for children.

- anger
- trouble in school
- fear
- behavioral problems
- guilt and sense of helplessness

Our **Healing the Bruises** program provides therapeutic interventions for child witnesses of family violence while providing parenting support to mothers.
